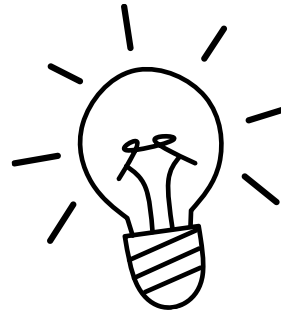


# THIS week on THE HILL

Pierce Dalton Brown, a student in Form 3, has demonstrated exceptional talent and dedication in sports, earning recognition as both a National Champion and a School Champion.

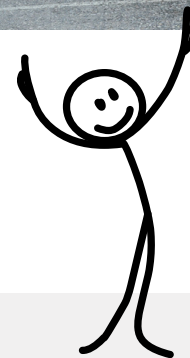
