Form 1 West and East started their studies on the relationship between religion and society in medieval England. They learned that a key part of English communities in 1097 were the orders of Monks and Nuns that brought education to the masses, relief to the poor and healing to the sick. Each order was based in a monastery or convent, each containing its own specialized facilities to assist those of the religious orders in their duties. The students were asked to construct replicas of monasteries and convents to help them deepen their understanding of the important role monks and nuns played in medieval society.
