MEET our Teacher

Angelique Basanta-Quiyou attended St. Joseph's Convent, St. Joseph, and graduated from Form 6 before continuing her studies at UWI, St. Augustine, where she earned a BSc and a postgraduate scholarship to pursue an MPhil in the Faculty of Engineering.

Next year marks 30 years of her work as an educator. She has held various roles, including teacher, curriculum officer, teacher assessor, exams coordinator, Principal's assistant, and more recently, assisting with IGCSE exams duties.

For the past 15 years, she has taught the Cambridge curriculum, first at The British Academy and, since 2021, at Rosewood-Trimont College. She teaches Science to lower forms and Biology to Forms 4 and 5.
